INTRODUCTION

1.1 Estimates of State Domestic Product are regarded as the most important single economic indicator to measure the economic development of a State. It measures in monetary terms, the volume of all goods and services produced within the boundaries of the state during a given period accounted without duplication. These estimates are prepared for various types of economic activities according to a standard methodology provided by CSO. These estimates depicts the level of development and are useful for proper planning, evaluating progress and inter-state comparisons and as such are a valuable tool in the hands of planners and policy makers. The State Domestic product takes into account exclusively the economic activities, whereas non-economic activities fall outside its preview. Thus the household services rendered by family workers such as one teaching his own children and unrecorded productive activities performed by producers outside their own trade have not been accounted for under the State Domestic Product. These activities have been classified into 15 main sectors.

1.2 For the first time, Economics and Statistical organization, Punjab estimated the SDP in 1967 with base year 1960-61 at constant prices as per the methodology provided by the Central Statistics Organization (CSO), New Delhi. With the gradual improvement in the availability of basic data over the years, a comprehensive review of methodology for SDP estimates has constantly been undertaken by the DES with a view to update the data base and shifting of the base year to a more recent year by following the methodology and the guiding

principles of the CSO, New Delhi. As a result, base years of the SDP were shifted from 1960-61 to 1970-71 in 1978, from 1970-71 to 1980-81 in 1988, from 1980-81 to 1993-94 in 1999, from 1993-94 to 1999-2000 in 2006 from 1999-2000 to 2004-05 in 2010 and from 2004-05 to 2011-12 in 2015. Along with the shifting of base years of SDP series, the DES had also been making improvements in the compilation of SDP series, in terms of coverage of activities, incorporation of latest datasets and latest guidelines provided by the CSO, New Delhi.

1.3 The method of SDP estimation is determined by the extent of availability of data. These estimates can be prepared by following any one of the three approaches given below: - (i) production (ii) income and (iii) expenditure.

Production Approach: In this approach, value of production is estimated without duplication and State Income is the sum of total of net output i.e. values of gross output less value of intermediate input and depreciation. This approach is followed to estimate the value added for the sectors like, Agriculture (including Livestock), Forestry, Fishery, Mining & Quarrying and Manufacturing (Registered) known as commodity producing sectors.

Income Approach: In this method income accrued to the factors of production like, land, labour and capital in the form of rent, salary and wages and other money value of benefits and interest along with the profit of the entrepreneur are considered to estimate the value added. The sectors for which this method is adopted are Manufacturing (Unregistered), Electricity, Gas and Water Supply,

Trade, Hotels & Restaurants, Transport, Storage & Communications. Financing and Insurance, Real Estate, Ownership of Dwellings, Business Services, Public Administration and other Services.

Expenditure Approach: This method is based on the measurement of income at the stage of disposal. The value added by Construction Sector is estimated in this method. Certain economic activities such as Railways, Communications, Banking & Insurance and Central Government Administration cut across state boundaries and thus their economic contribution cannot be assessed at state level. These activities are known as supra regional activities. The domestic product for this supra regional sectors are compiled for the country as a whole and allocated to the states on the basis of relevant indicators.

1.4 The reason for periodically changing the base year of the SDP series is to take into account the structural changes, which have been taking place in the economy, and to depict a true picture of the economy through GSDP, NSDP, and Per capita income. SDP estimates are prepared at the prices of selected year known as base year to judge, the performance of the economy in real terms. The SDP estimates at the prevailing prices during the peak market period of the current year are termed as "at current prices", while those prepared at base year prices are termed as "at constant prices".

Guiding Principles of New Series

State Domestic Product of Punjab – 2015-16

The Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) has been the most important indicator in measuring the economic growth of the State. The GSDP estimates briefs us about the changes in the level of economic development. In this outlook, we would like to present the detailed structure of Punjab's economy.

1. Adoption of New Base Year:

The Gross State Domestic Product (State Income) Estimates are being prepared by adopting the new base year 2011-12 at par with Central Statistics Office (C.S.O.). The GSDP estimates are compiled at "Market Prices" in the new series instead of "Factor Cost". The Market Price includes 'product taxes' minus 'product subsidies'. As such, statistical comparisons between the old and new base year cannot be drawn for GSDP from 2011-12 onwards.

2. Sources and Methodology to compute the GSDP with 2011-12 as base year:

A brief introduction about the changes in sources and methodology to compute the GSDP in the revised new base year is presented below:

- In 2004-05 series GSDP was being compiled at 'factor cost' but in new 2011-12 series, the GSDP estimates are being prepared at 'Market Prices'
GSDP at Market Prices = Gross State Value Added at Basic Prices + Product Taxes – Product Subsidies

- Enterprise approach has replaced *Establishment approach* in the Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) from 2012-13 and post manufacturing activity has also been included in the estimation of GVA.
- In the new series, *MCA-21* (Ministry of Corporate Affairs) data has been used in the estimation of Private Corporate Sector GVA.
- In manufacturing sector, All India Corporate estimates are allocated to the States based on the State's *ASI ratios* to arrive at Private Corporate Sector.
- The estimates of Computer related services was based on the proportion of private corporate workforce as revealed from Employment and Unemployment Survey (EUS) of NSSO in 2004-05 series. In 2011-12 series these allocations are based on the proportion of software exports made by the State (information collected from annual reports of Software Technology Parks of India – STPI). Due to this revision the GSDP of computer related services has increased substantially.
- In the new series, the estimates of Agriculture and Livestock sector, Trade, Hotels and Restaurants sector are calculated separately. Transport sector estimates have been individualized as Road Transport, Water Transport, Air Transport and Services Incidental to Transport.

3. Change in Sources:

Further, the following results of latest surveys and census have also been incorporated:

- ❖ Population Census, 2011;
- ❖ All India Livestock Census, 2012;
- ❖ NSS 68th round (2011-12) - Survey on Employment & Unemployment and Household Consumption Expenditure;

- ❖ NSS 67th round (2010-11) – Survey on Unincorporated Non-agricultural Enterprises
- ❖ NSS 70th round (2013) – All India Debt and Investment Survey

4. Outlook for 2017-18:

The GSDP estimates have been released for the year 2017-18(AE) with base year 2011-12. According to the estimates, GSDP at current prices is Rs.471301 crore in 2017-18 showing a growth rate of 10.03%. The growth rate of GSDP at constant (2011-12)prices decreased from 6.78% in 2016-17 to 5.68% in 2017-18 due to decline in the growth rate of agriculture sector from 6.72% in 2016-17(as per quick estimates) to 2.87% in 2017-18 (as per advance estimates). The growth rate of secondary sector has decreased from 5.38% in 2016-17 to 3.98% in 2017-18 and tertiary sector has increased from 6.92% in 2016-17 to 7.17% during 2017-18.

5. Advance Estimates of Gross State Domestic Product (2017-18):

Gross State Domestic Product of Punjab at Constant (2011-12) Prices is Rs.372423 crore showing a growth rate of 5.68% in 2017-18. The Gross Value Added from 'Manufacturing' sector is expected to grow at 4.98% in 2017-18. The expected GSVA growth rate of 'Electricity, Gas and Water Supply' is around 4.74%. The expected GSVA growth rate of 'Crops' is 2.87%. This is due to fall in food grain production during 2017-18. The expected growth rate of GSVA from services sector which includes Trade, Hotels & Restaurants, Transport, Storage & Communication, Real estate and Professional Services & Ownership of dwellings, Public Administration and Other Services is 7.17% in 2017-18.

6. Comparison of GSDP of Punjab and GDP of All India:

At constant (2011-12) prices, the anticipated GSDP at Market prices of Punjab is expected to grow at 5.7 % during 2017-18 compared to 6.8% in 2016-17. At national level, the GDP estimates at constant (2011-12) prices is expected to grow at 6.5% in 2017-18 compared to 7.1% in 2016-17. The growth rates of GSDP and GDP at constant (2011-12) prices from 2011-12 to 2017-18 are given below:

7. Net State Domestic Product:

The estimates of Net State Domestic Product (NSDP) are derived from the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) by deducting Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC) or Depreciation. The estimated NSDP at Constant (2011-12) prices is Rs.332302 crore in 2017-18 compared to Rs. 314402 crore in 2016-17, showing a growth rate of 4.33% in 2017-18 against 5.24% in 2016-17.

8. Sectoral Composition of Gross State Domestic Product:

The composition of GSDP of agriculture & allied activities sector saw a marginal increase from 29.19% to 29.22% in 2017-18 against 2016-17 whereas secondary sector which comprises mainly of manufacturing, electricity, gas & water-supply and construction sector saw a marginal decrease from 24.57% in 2016-17 to 23.83% in 2017-18. Services sector has been contributing as the largest component of GSDP. Services sector which mainly includes Trade, Hotels & restaurants, Transport, Storage & Communication, Public Administration and Banking sector has contributed 46.94% in 2017-18 to GSDP as compared to 46.22% in 2016-17.

The Sectoral Composition of GSDP in 2016-17 and 2017-18 at current prices is given in **Table** below:

9. Per Capita Income:

Per Capita Income (PCI) is estimated by dividing NSDP at current prices with mid-financial year projected population. Per Capita Income (i.e. per capita NSDP) of Punjab at current prices is estimated at Rs. 140872 during 2017-18, against Rs.128890 in 2016-17, an increase of 9.30%. Per Capita Income at constant (2011-12) prices is expected to increase from Rs.105386 in 2016-17 to Rs. 109946 in 2017-18 with an increase of 4.33%.

Methodology to Compute Estimates of Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP)

1. Introduction

In the context of planned development of any economy, estimates of State Domestic Product (SDP) as well as per capita income play a vital role. It is one of the important indicator for measuring the regional disparities between states as well as the overall impact of various developmental programmes within the state. These estimates, when studied over a period of time, would reveal real growth in the level of development of economy of a state and would facilitate proper formulation and appraisal of plans for balanced economic development.

2. The Background:

The state income can be defined as a set of systematic statistical statements which reflect the value of the total output produced in the various sectors of the economy such as agriculture, forestry, fishing, industry, transport, trade, banking, other services, etc., together with details of distribution of factor incomes among different groups and final expenditure of the economy. From the production of goods and services to their final disposal, innumerable transactions take place. This helps one to understand, in a nutshell, how these various transactions are inter-related and gives an idea of the working of the economy.

3. Objectives:

In the context of planned development of any economy, estimates of State Domestic Product (SDP) as well as Per Capita Income play a vital role in

formulating policies of the Government. It is one of the important indicators for measuring the regional disparities between states as well as the overall impact of various developmental programmes within the state. If these estimates are reliable and sufficiently detailed, they give a true picture of the economic structure of a state. These estimates, when studied over a period of time, would reveal real growth in the level of development of economy of a state. This would facilitate policy makers, administrators and planners for proper formulation and appraisal of plans for balanced economic development.

4. Organization:

The directorate of Economics and Statistics is responsible for collecting the required data from various departments, organizations and through sample surveys for preparation of SDP estimates. The Heads of various Departments and Organizations are responsible for supply of basic data for the preparation of SDP estimates; as such they are referred to as primary data suppliers.

5. Concept and Definition;

‘Income originating’ concept at state level and **‘Income accruing’** concept at the National level is adopted in the preparation of income estimates. Variation in concepts is due to the non-availability of accurate /reliable data on income flows concept across the boundaries of the state.

The State Domestic Product is defined as the **“aggregate of the economic value of all goods and services produced within the geographical boundaries of the state, counted without duplication, for a specified period of time”** by convention: a financial year.

6. Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM):

In the previous (2004-05) base, the FISIM component of the output of financial intermediaries was based on the difference between total property receipts (dividend + interest + net profit on sale of investments) and total interest payments by banking sector. In the present (2011-12) base, the FISIM has been computed only on loans and deposits, using the Reference Rate (RR) approach, as recommended in the SNA 2008. In short, it is $(LR-RR) * \text{average stock of loans} + (RR-DR) * \text{average stock of deposits}$. The RR = harmonic mean of lending rate and deposit rate for the banking sector. Moreover, FISIM, under the present method, does not include interest receipts on investments and debt securities, interest paid on borrowing and debt securities and net profit on sale of investments (POSI). These components have been considered as property income and come directly under the gross savings of the financial corporations. Exclusion of receipts like POSI from the FISIM computation has also reduced the GVA of the banking sector.

It is an imputed income, equivalent to interest and dividend receipts of banking and financial enterprises. The net amount of interest paid to depositors is defined as FISIM (income earned for services rendered) and is entered as receipt item in the output of the financial enterprises. The output of the financial enterprises thus includes interest received, which was paid by the producing industries. As the interest paid by the industries is already accounted for in the Gross Value Added (GVA) of respective industries, its inclusion in the GVA of Banking industry amounts to duplication. To avoid this duplication, FISIM is allocated to the user industries as an intermediate input.

$$\text{GVA adjusted} = \text{GVA unadjusted-FISIM}$$

7. Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC):

Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC), also termed as ‘Depreciation’ is defined as that part of the gross product which is required to replace the fixed capital used up in the process of production during the period of account. At present, these estimates of CFC for all sectors of the economy are supplied by CSO.

8. Measures relating to income:

Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) represents the sum of economic value of all goods and services produced within the geographical boundary of a state after deducting the necessary inputs consumed in the process of production and the Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM). From this Gross State Domestic Product, Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC) is deducted to arrive at the Net State Domestic Product (NSDP), which is normally termed as State Income.

$$\text{NSDP} = \text{GSDP} - \text{CFC}$$

The estimate of total GSDP/NSDP so arrived at is divided by the estimated mid-financial year population to get per capita GSDP/ per capita NSDP. The per capita NSDP at current prices is termed as ‘Per Capita Income (PCI)’.

$$\text{PCI} = \text{NSDP at Current Prices} / \text{Mid-Financial year population}$$

9. Division of Economy into sectors:-

For estimating SDP, the economy of state is broadly classified into the following three sectors, based on the similar pattern to that of the national income, which is as follows:

10. Method of Estimation:

The estimates of SDP from the above sectors are prepared individually by adopting one or more of the following three approaches.

1. Production approach:

This approach involves evaluation of all goods and services produced within the state during a period of time from which inputs and depreciation are deducted, to get the estimates of income.

2. Income approach:

In this method the aggregate income is viewed to have been distributed among the four factors of production viz, Land, Labour, Capital and Enterprises in the form of rent, wages, interest and profits.

3. Expenditure approach:

This is based on measurement of income at the stage of disposal. All that is produced is either ultimately consumed or a part of it is saved for future consumption or future production of goods and services. The money value of consumption expenditure plus the savings gives the income.

11. Base year:

The GSDP is measured for an accounting year in the state, at the prices prevailed during that accounting year. When this is compared over the years, the GSDP is affected by the changes in production as well as change in prices. To eliminate the effect of prices, the GSDP will be prepared at the prices of selected year known as “base year”.

In the past, GSDP was revised decennially by changing the base to a year, which ends with ‘1’. It was primarily because, in the base year estimates of income aggregates, the information on work force plays an important role and work force estimates are obtained from population Census conducted decennially in the year ending with 1(eg.1970-1971, 1980-1981, etc).This practice continued up to the series with base year 1980-1981. Since then, the CSO started using the work force estimates from the results of Quinquennial Employment and Unemployment Surveys conducted by National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) earlier called the National Sample Survey Organization and consequently started revising the base year of National Accounts Statistics once in every five years coinciding with the year for which the NSSO conducts the Quinquennial Employment and Unemployment Surveys. The National Statistical Commission has also recommended that all economic indices should be rebased at least once in every five year. Further, while revising the base year, implementation of their recommendations of the System of National Accounts (SNA) as and when the

SNA is revised at the international level are also taken into consideration to the extent of data availability .At the National level, the CSO has already prepared and released the estimates in 2011-12 series.

In new base year 2011-12, Public sector is divided into Public Non-Financial Corporations, Public Financial Corporations & General Government and Private Sector is divided into Private Non-Financial Corporations & Private Financial Corporations. Implementation of SNA 2008 and comprehensive coverage of corporate sector has been ensured in mining, manufacturing and services by incorporation of annual accounts of companies as available with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA). Further, the results of recent surveys, censuses and type studies have also been used.

STATE DOMESTIC PRODUCT OF PUNJAB-2015-16

1. Crop Sector

Estimates of GSDP are prepared by following the production method.

Agriculture Output: The gross value of output (GVO) of each crop is obtained as a product of area, yield and price (or production and price), as the case may be. The estimates of area and output of principal crops are from the Directorate of Agriculture, Punjab. For evaluation purposes of these crops, the Producers' Prices, corresponding to average wholesale prices prevailing in the primary markets during the peak marketing periods are adopted. The wholesale prices are collected by the Agriculture produce marketing committees of State Agriculture Marketing Department.

In case of such crops for which production data is available, valuation of crop output is done by multiplying the quantities of production with the corresponding producer's price. The sources of data used and the method of preparation of estimates of value of output are given as here under:

- The estimates of turn-outs for principal crops are based on the results of the Crop Estimation Surveys conducted annually by the State Government Agencies. These are compiled and published annually by the State Agriculture Department in the form of Annual Season and Crop Report (ASCR). For evaluation purposes of these crops, the Producer's Prices, corresponding to average wholesale prices prevailing in the primary markets during the peak marketing periods are adopted.

- The wholesale prices are collected by the Agriculture Produce Marketing Committees of State Agriculture Departments. For averaging the weekly wholesale prices available from the selected primary markets, the following procedures are adopted
- Arithmetic averaging of the prices at the various centers within a district is done to get the weekly district prices, for each crop.
- **Average** price for a district, is worked out as the arithmetic average over the ‘peak marketing periods’ of weekly prices obtained as above.
- **State** average price is obtained as a weighted average of the district wise prices, weights being the district-wise production of the corresponding crops.

In case of horticulture crops (fruits and vegetables) and Floriculture, information on area and output is taken from the State Horticulture Department (SHD)/National Horticulture Board (NHB), depending upon the data availability. Similarly, in case of sugarcane, output excluding the quantity of crop converted into Gur by cane growers is estimated and output of Gur is evaluated separately. The estimates of output for miscellaneous and unspecified crops are obtained by applying the appropriate average value of Yield per hectare (YPH) and the area under the crop. The value of byproducts viz.: stalks, straws, etc are estimated by applying the yield per hectare as available from the cost of cultivation studies (CCS).

In respect of unspecified and miscellaneous crop and crop groups viz.; (a) other cereals (b) other oil seeds (C) other sugars (d) other fibers (e) dyes and tanning materials (f) other drugs and narcotics (g) other condiments and spices (h) other fruits and vegetables and (i) miscellaneous crops (fodder, grass, misc. food and non food crop), the turn-out estimates are not directly available for all these

crops. To the extent possible, only data on related crop is utilized .The value of output in respect of these crop groups is estimated by utilizing area estimates under these crop groups as available from the annual publication, ‘Land Utilization Statistics (LUS)’ of state agencies. To arrive at value of yield per hectare to the total estimated area under each of these groups /crop groups, the estimates of value of output is obtained by applying following method.

In respect of production of the fruits and vegetable crops grown in foreyard/backyard of houses is included in the value of output of agriculture sector.

Government Irrigation System: In respect of operation of irrigation system by government sources, income approach is used. The gross factor income generated as a result of providing irrigation services is estimated. The operation of irrigation system by the agriculturists is not separately taken into account as its output gets reflected in the value of output of crops and expenditure on its operation in the overall inputs costs.

2. Livestock Sector:

The Livestock sector for the purpose of estimation of value of output has been divided into 7 groups. The groups are (i) Milk, (ii) Meat, (iii) Eggs, (iv) Wool, (v) Dung, (vi) Silk worm, Cocoons and Honey and (vii) Increment in stocks. Evaluation of Livestock production is calculated by multiplying the quantities of production by the corresponding producer's prices. State Animal Husbandry conducts every year, the integrated Sample Survey (ISS), covering milk, egg, meat and wool. The data on livestock population is estimated using the results of five-yearly livestock censuses. Using the projected livestock population and yield estimates (CSO), the estimates of production of livestock products (meat product, meat by products and other products) are compiled. AH& VS furnishes production of meat and their prices and also it furnishes data on number of slaughtered animals. The latest Livestock Census results are used to generate annual data on population of various categories of livestock. The estimates of camel hair, goat hair and pig bristles are prepared on the basis of information on yield per animal available from the studies conducted by CSO.

The estimates of production of dung (used as manure and fuel) are prepared on the basis of data on utilization rates of dung /droplets for (a) dung used as manure and (b) dung used as fuel available in ISS. In 2011-12 series, the value of evacuation /droplet from goat and sheep has been estimated using the prices of dung and the said value is included in the estimates.

The annual outturn of estimates of silkworm, cocoons from Central Silk Board (CSB) on regular basis to provide the requisite information on these items.

The annual net increase in the population is estimated respectively for each category of livestock on the basis of livestock population projections. The population is projected on the basis of inter-censal population growth of animals. The latest livestock Census results are used for this purpose. The prices of livestock products are collected from Department of Animal Husbandry.

Inputs: The cost of inputs of crop sector and livestock sector are evaluated separately. The inputs are Seed, Current repairs & maintenance of fixed assets and other operational costs, fertilizer, organic manure, feed of livestock, irrigation charges, market charges, electricity, diesel oil and repairs and maintenance.

3. Forestry and Logging:

The forest products are classified into two broad categories viz; (a) major products comprising industrial wood (timber, round wood, match and pulpwood) & fuel wood (firewood and charcoal wood) and (b) minor products.

Estimates of GSDP are prepared by following the production method. Gross value of output is estimated separately for (a) Industrial wood, (b) Trees outside Forest (ToF), (c) Fuel wood and (d) Minor forest products. Estimates of industrial wood are based on data received from the State Forest Department (SFD) for recorded production and their prices. The value of the fuel wood, from the consumption side, is estimated using the latest results of NSSO on consumption expenditure surveys during the previous two quinquennial rounds. The estimates so derived are reduced by the actual value of agriculture by products, namely, Cotton sticks, Arhar sticks, Sesamum, Mustard & Rapeseed, Sunflowers and Baggase, which is taken into account in the agriculture activity (to avoid double counting), since these by-products are consumed as fuel by the households. These estimates are then inflated by 7.64 percent to account for consumption of fuel wood by the industries and on funerals. Estimates of minor forest products are based on data directly available from State Forest Department. Inputs are taken as 16.2 per cent of the value of output is.

4. Fishing:

Estimates of GSDP of this activity are prepared by following the production method. GVO is estimated from output and prices of inland fish as furnished by the Fisheries Department. Estimates of subsistence fishing are also included in the GSDP of the state which is estimated at 12.5% of the value of output of inland fish. The value of inputs and operational costs is taken as 10% and 1% of the GVO for the items, inland fish and subsistence fish respectively, as supplied by the CSO.

5. Mining and Quarrying:

In the earlier series, the estimates of GSDP in this industry has been compiled following the production method of calculating the value of output of each mineral in the state and deducting the value of corresponding inputs. Mineral-wise data on output (production & prices) of all minerals (except minor

minerals) are obtained from the publication of Indian Bureau of Mines (IBM), Nagpur. Production in respect of minor minerals is collected from State Geology Department. The deductible rates (i.e. inputs) in respect of all minerals, except minor minerals and fuel minerals are obtained from IBM. Input rates for minor minerals are based on NSSO survey or IBM.

In the new series, the GVA has been computed from the annual financial statement of the companies for non-department enterprise and private corporate enterprises available from MCA21 database. The Methodology has been revised from the establishment approach to enterprise approach. Hence, apart from metallic and non-metallic minerals and minor minerals, the additional items included in this sector are coal, petroleum and natural gas.

6. Manufacturing (Organized and Un-organized):

(i) Organized Manufacturing:

In earlier series, for the purpose of estimation of GSDP, the entire manufacturing activities were classified into two broad segment, namely, manufacturing 'registered' and 'unregistered'. In the new series, with base year 2011-12, the manufacturing sector has been reclassified into Organized Manufacturing and Un-organized Manufacturing. Organized Manufacturing comprises of Public Sector Companies, Private corporate sector from ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) data base and quasi-corporation as covered by Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) apart from the Department Enterprises (DCUs) like Railway Workshops, Government of India Printing Press and Ordnance Factories. Estimates of GSDP for organized manufacturing are prepared by following the production method. The industry-wise estimates for organized manufacturing are compiled by summing up the estimates from DE's, NDE's, Private Corporate Sector Enterprises, Non-Corporate manufacturing establishment covered under ASI and the quasi-corporations of the unincorporated enterprises.

For the years for which above results are not available, the growth observed in the state Index of Industrial Production (IIP) and Wholesale Price Index (WPI) have been used.

(ii). Un-organized Manufacturing

The unorganized manufacturing consists of the household enterprises. This segment covers all the manufacturing, processing, repair & maintenance services

of units employing less than 10 workers(using power) or less than 20 workers (not using power). By implication, it also covers own account enterprises (OAE) engaged in manufacturing activities. Estimates for manufacturing (unorganized) are first compiled for the base year.

7. Electricity, Gas, Water Supply and Remediation Services:

Electricity: The GSDP estimates in this sub-sector are prepared using the income method. The estimates are based on the annual accounts of State Power Generation, Transmission and Distribution Companies, MCA 21 database for the Private Sector Companies and other electricity undertaking located in the State. The value added estimates of central undertaking viz. National Thermal Power Corporation, National Hydro Power Corporation and Power Grid Corporation made available by the CSO are also added.

Gas: This sub-sector comprises of Gobar Gas. The estimates of GSDP in respect of Gobar Gas are prepared on the basis of value of production per plant

which is estimated on the basis of data provided by the Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) multiplied by the total number of plants installed up to the current year, as furnished by Ministry of Non-Conventional Energy sources. Further, companies in the Private Corporate Sector are being captured through the MCA 21 database.

Water Supply: The estimates of SDP for water supply are compiled for the public and private (both corporate and unorganized) sectors separately following the income approach.

Water Supply-Public sector: The estimates of public sector in respect of State Government are culled out from the Budget documents whereas those for Local Bodies are based on the information obtained State Water Supply & Sewerage Board and Budget Link documents for Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs) and Urban Local Bodies (ULBs).

Water-Supply Private sector: The estimates of private sector are prepared separately for Rural and urban areas using NSS workforce and average compensation of municipal workers engaged in Water Supply services and MCA21 database for Private Sector Companies.

Remediation and other utility services: The estimates for this sector have been compiled by aggregating the estimates for recycling, remediation, sewerage and other waste management services. The estimates for recycling in the organized sector have been obtained from ASI, while those or the remaining services have been estimated by aggregating the estimates of DE's and Enterprises of the Private Corporate Sector. Estimates for the Unincorporated Enterprises have been computed using the NSS data on Unincorporated

Enterprises and Employment Unemployment survey. As in the case of unincorporated manufacturing, the unincorporated enterprises are classified as quasi-corporations, if they are maintaining account and otherwise, as household enterprises.

8. Construction:

In the earlier series, the estimates of value added from construction activity were prepared independently for the following categories by adopting income method, i.e. by taking into account the expenditures made on construction.

- Public sector covering (1) State Government administrative departments local bodies, all state departmental enterprises of both, state and local bodies (2) Central government administrative department and departmental enterprises other than Railways, Communication and repair and maintenance expenditure in respect of Defence services (3) Railways (4) Communications (5) non-departmental commercial undertaking excluding Air and Water transport, Banking and Insurance (only capital expenditure)

- Household Sector covering (1) Rural residential building (2) Urban residential building (3) Rural non-residential (4) Urban non residential building and (5) Rural and Urban other construction work.
- Residual comprising of construction undertaken by private corporate sector, other private un-incorporate enterprises and private non-profit institutions including quasi corporate bodies, besides part of public sector namely air and water transport, banking and insurance, public nonprofit institutions including quasi-Government bodies, plantations, mineral explorations, repair and maintenance expenditure in respect of Defence Services and the entire repair and maintenance expenditure in respect of non-departmental commercial undertaking.

In the earlier series, the data on expenditure on new construction, repair and maintenance of the state government administrative department and their departmental enterprises and available from the budget document .For local bodies, the expenditure data on construction directly collected from the local bodies in the state were used for estimation of GVA. Further, data on capital expenditure for Non Departmental Commercial Undertaking (NDCU) was used for estimation of GVA .Data on expenditure on new construction and repair and maintenance of the Central Government Administrative Departments (except for Defence Services) and their departmental enterprises (except railways and communication) are made available by the CSO.

The estimates of expenditure on new construction and repairs and maintenance in rural and urban residential buildings are available in the latest All India Debt & Investment Survey (AIDIS) and these estimates of expenditure on new construction and repair & maintenance are moved to later years with the help of geometric growth rate of rural and urban census dwelling based on previous

two population Censuses data. Price change are superimposed with the help of the index of cost of construction of rural/urban buildings to obtain the estimates at current prices .The estimates of rural and urban non-residential building as available from AIDIS are moved to later years with the help of weighted index of GVO from ‘agriculture proper’ and ‘registered manufacturing’. The estimates of GVO from residual category are made available by CSO.

In the 2011-12 series, the details of method of estimation are given below:

(A) Public Sector:

(B) General Government: In case of State Government Administration and Local Bodies, estimates of NVA from construction are taken from the state budget documents.NVA consists of the outlays on salary and wages under the capital account heads 4059, 4216 and 5054 of budget documents. In respect of Central Administration, the data on NVA is as supplied by the CSO.

(C) Departmental Commercial Undertaking (DCU): Construction output for DCUs (excluding Railways and Communication) is prepared using the outlays on (i) construction (building, roads & bridges and other construction and (ii) repair & maintenance from analysis of Central and State Govt. Budgets. The output for DCUs in supra regional sector Railways and Communication is estimated separately at the national level. This estimate of GVA for DCUs is allocated to state using the suitable indicator and same is made available.

(D) Non-Departmental Commercial Undertaking (NDCU): State-wise GVA estimates of NDCUs are obtained by analyzing the Central and State annual reports of NDCUs and after appropriate allocation of central NDCUs to state .Then estimates of GVA is supplied to the state.

(B) Household Sector:

I. Rural Residential Building (RRB), Urban Residential Building (URB) and Non Residential Building and Other Construction Works (NRB&OCW): There is not much change in methodology apart from updating of benchmark estimates based on NSS survey results of All India Debt and Investment Survey (AIDIS) 2013. The survey results are used for compilation of base year (2011-12) estimates of output of RRB, URB and NRB & OCW.

For latest years, the estimates of RRB and URB are first compiled at constant (2011-12) prices, using yearly inter-censal growth rate of dwelling. Weighted index (W.I) of RRB and URB is used to arrive at current prices estimates. These weighted indexes (W.I) of RRB and URB are compiled using price indices of different items, given below:-

GVA estimates of RRB, URB and NRB&OCW for base year (2011-12) are compiled by applying GVA to output Ratio on output.

II Other Households: Other Household sector is a residual estimate of Household sector, which consists of Non Profit Institutions Serving Households (NPISH) and other areas of Household sector, which are not covered due to non-availability of reliable data sources. State-wise GVA estimates of Other Household is compiled by allocating the All India estimates of Other Household among States using a composite weighted indicator, which is prepared on the basis of State-wise consumption of Cement, Iron & Steel using certain weights. State-wise consumption of cement data, latest available for 2010-11 from cement manufacturers association has been used to estimate the State-wise cement consumed in construction industry. State-wise value of iron & Steel used for construction is estimated on the basis of the value of cement used with the

assumption that the use of iron & steel in construction industry is directly proportional to consumption of cement.

(III). Plantation: State-wise estimates of plantation is compiled by allocating the All India GVA estimate of plantation(household only) among States on the basis of State-wise area and ALL India estimate of each plantation crop.

Added Residual: Residual estimates mainly consist of Private Corporations and other residual part of public sector. All India Residual estimate is allocated among States using composite weighted indicator used for allocation of All India estimate of “Other Household”.

9. Transport:

The economic activities covered in this sector are (i) transport by railways, (ii) transport other than Railways namely Land transport (mechanized

and non-mechanized) water transport (coastal, ocean, inland) air transport and services incidental to transport (iii) storage and (iv) communication services rendered by Post & Tele-communication Department and Overseas Communication Services. Institutional sector of this activity comprises of Public corporations, private unincorporated sector (Quasi-corporations and household sector).

a. Railway:

Estimates of GSDP for railway are considered as part of supra-regional sector and estimates for this sector are provided by the CSO.

Transport other than Railways: The economic activities covered in this sector are (i) Road transport; (ii) Air transport; (iii) Water transport (iv) Services incidental to transport.

b. Road transport:

Public sector: The estimates of GSDP for this segment are obtained through annual report/accounts for NDCUs in the state.

Private sector: Private corporate estimates have been compiled using MCA21 database .The estimates of GVA at current prices for private unorganized sector is prepared activity-wise by multiplying work force with value added per worker(VAPW) separately for the rural and urban areas for the base year. This value will be moved with combines index of vehicles registered under the three categories (bus, fight and other transport) of road transport.

c. Water Transport:

The estimates of GSDP for organized inland water transport in respect of a state are taken from the annual account of state inland water transport companies or State Budget document. Estimates of gross value added from the shipping companies in public and private segment, ports and pilot ages, lighthouse , ships handled by the Central and Dredging Corporation of India and Inland Water Authority and Private corporate estimates have been compiled using MCA21 data are supplied by the CSO.

d. Air Transport:

Private corporate estimates have been compiled using MCA21 database. The GVA for this part is made available by the CSO.

e. Service Incidental to Transport:

The economic activities covered under this are Airport Authority and part of water transport .The estimates of Non- Mechanized and Service incidental have been moved to further years with help of combined vehicle index. Private corporate estimates have been compiled using MCA21 database and the same is made available by the CSO.

10. Storage:

The economic activities covered in this sector are: (i) Warehousing (Public Corporations) (ii) Cold Storage (Private Corporate) (iii) Storage not elsewhere classified (n.e.c) (Unorganized Enterprises).

The estimates in respect of public warehousing (other than central Warehousing Corp.) are based on the annual accounts of warehousing corporation.

The value added from Central Warehousing Corporation, Cold Storage and storage n.e.c private corporate estimates have been compiled using MCA21 database and the same is made available by the CSO.

11. Communication and Services relating to broadcasting:

Activities covered in this sector are courier, Cable operators, Telecommunication and Recording, Publishing & Broadcasting services. Institutional sectors of this activity comprises of Public corporations, Private Corporate (excluding Quasi-corporations) and Private unincorporated sector (Quasi-corporations and household sector).

Public: Estimates of GSDP communications are considered as part of supra-regional sector and estimates for these sectors are provided by the CSO

Private: This comprises of Private Corporate (excluding quasi-corporations) and Private unincorporated sector (Quasi-corporation and household sector). For Private Corporate, estimates have been compiled using MCA21 database and the same is made available by the CSO. In respect of Private unincorporated sector (Quasi-corporations and household sector), the estimates of GVA for the base year have been compiled using the estimated VAPW from latest NSS results and the estimated workforce in the respective activities separately for Rural/urban areas. For subsequent years, estimates are moved using growth in suitable indicators of the relevant service.

12. Trade, Repair, Hotels and Restaurants:

Trade activity includes wholesale and retail trade in all commodities whether produced domestically, imported or exported and Repair services of computers, household goods and motor vehicles (including motor cycles).

The estimates of GSDP for this segment of activities are prepared separately for public and private (organized and un-organized) components.

Public Sector: The estimates of GSDP for public part in the Center are prepared and supplied by the CSO whereas the part relating to state governments are prepared by the State DES on the basis of the budget documents of state/local government and annual account of NDCUs.

Private organized part: Private organized part comprising private corporate sector, quasi-corporations and co-operative societies engaged in the trade, repair services, hotel and restaurants. Estimates of Private Incorporated Enterprises have

been derived using the MCA 21 database. Estimates for this part are made available by the CSO.

Private un-organized: The base year estimates of private un-organized sector of Trade, Hotel and Restaurants have been prepared as a product of VAPW and work force. For trade sector the workforce estimates have been prepared using the results of latest NSS on EUS along with data on population from latest Population Census. The VAPW is available in the latest NSS round. In the case of hotels and restaurants, the VAPW is taken from the latest Enterprise survey results of NSS. For the base year, the estimates from private un-organized sector of trade and hotels and restaurants are prepared separately. For subsequent years, the base year estimates of trade, hotels and restaurants are moved with the help of growth in tax collection at current and constant prices and hotels & restaurants are moved with the index of arrivals of foreign tourists to India.

This sector is part of a supra-regional sector and estimates of GSDP are provided by the CSO.

14. Real Estate, Ownership of Dwelling and Professional Services:

The economic activities covered in this sector are (1) Real Estate and Professional services, which comprises of (i) Real estate activities; (ii) Computer & information related services; (iii) Professional, scientific and technical activities including R&D and (iv) Administrative and support services activities and other professional activities and (2) Ownership of dwelling (occupied residential houses). Institutional sectors of this activities comprises of Public corporation, Private Corporate (excluding quasi-corporations) and Private unincorporated sector (Quasi-corporations and household sector).

The estimates of value added per worker (VAPW) and the estimates of workforce are from latest NSS round, separately for Rural/Urban. Private

organized/un-organized sector has been used to estimate the Gross Value Added from Real Estate, Renting of Machinery & Equipment without operator and of Personal and household goods, information and computer related activities of Un-organized sector, Legal activities, Accounting & Book Keeping, Research & Development (other professional services and veterinary activities). For subsequent years, the estimates of workforce have been worked out by using the inter survey exponential growth rate of EUSs as observed between two latest results of NSS and VAPW have been moved to subsequent year using the suitable indicators for rural and urban areas.

Estimates for organized part of computer and related activities are prepared using NASSCOM data and for Private Corporate, estimates have been compiled using MCA21 database. These estimates are made available by the CSO.

Ownership of Dwelling:

GSDP estimates for the ownership of dwelling were estimated as the gross rental of the residential census houses less the cost of repair and maintenance. This method has been followed in estimating urban dwelling; the data on dwelling and rental per dwelling for urban areas has been taken from latest Population Census and NSS on consumer expenditure respectively. For subsequent year, estimates of census residential houses are prepared using the inter-censal growth rate for urban areas. The rent per household is moved to subsequent years with the index of house rent sub-group in CPI (Urban). The GVA of rural part of ownership of dwelling is supplied by CSO.

15. Public Administration:

Gross Value Added (GVA) is estimated by the “Income Approach”. The compensation of employees of administrative department is taken from the budget of the State and Local authorities .The estimates of value added in respect of Central Government Administration , being a supra-regional activity, are prepared and supplied by the CSO. These are added to the estimates of Central Government Administration to obtain the estimates of public administration.

16. Other services:

The economic activities covered under this sector are (i) education services; (ii) human health & care services (iii) recreation, culture and sporting activities (iv) Activities of membership organization (v) Personal services including washing, hairdressing, custom tailoring and other personal services activities and (vi) Private household with employed persons. The activities of extra territorial organizations and bodies are not a part of GSDP and have been excluded from this group. The categories 'Sewerage and refuse disposal' and 'veterinary services' have been removed from this group and classified as a part of utility services in 'Electricity, gas, water supply and utility services' group and 'professional services' respectively. Institutional sector of this activity comprises of Public (General Government and Public corporation), Private corporate (excluding quasi-corporations) and Private unincorporated sector (Quasi-corporations and household sector).

The estimates of GVA for private corporate and unorganized part of these activities have been prepared for the base year following the labour input method using the results of latest NSS round on employment and unemployment and services sector .For subsequent years, the estimates of labour input are prepared using the inter-survey growth rates in the workforce. The VAPW of rural and urban areas are projected to subsequent years with the suitable indicators respectively.

The GVA for the public sector has been taken to be equivalent to the budget expenditure on salaries and wages of personnel engaged in the respective activities, particularly in education, medical & health and sanitary services. For Private Corporate, estimates have been compiled using MCA21 data base made available by the CSO.

METHODOLOGY FOR DISTRICT- INCOME ESTIMATES

The methodology for preparation of District income estimates is very much depends on availability of basic data at district level. The database at the District level is far from satisfaction for estimation of income at the district level. Nevertheless, the data in respect of Primary Sector is fairly sound, but appears to be very scanty in respect of remaining sectors. Therefore the district level data could be utilized to the extent of its availability to compute the district income estimates adapting the state level methodology. In the case of non-commodity producing sectors, where the district wise basic data are not available, the state level estimates are allocated to the districts on the basis of suitable district wise indicators. Further, in some of the commodity producing sectors, though the district wise production and price data is available, the corresponding input data may not be available. In such cases, district wise production and price data is used and state level input data is utilized for preparation of district income estimates.

Industry wise details of methodology for preparation of District Domestic Product are given in the following paragraphs.

Agriculture: Gross value of output in agriculture sector is obtained as a product of district-wise production of agriculture crops including their by products and average wholesale prices prevalent in the selected marketing centers of district during the peak marketing period. The state level estimates (GSVA) of this sector are allocated to the districts on the basis of percentage of GVO of agriculture sector.

Livestock: The gross value of output is obtained as a product of district-wise strength and production of different livestock categories and their respective prices collected from selected centers in each district. The input cost worked out at the State level is allocated to the districts according to the proportionate gross value of output from this sector in each district.

Forestry and Logging: The state level estimates of GSVA from this sector are allocated to the districts on the basis of district wise area under forests.

Fisheries: The GSVA of this sector is allocated to districts in ratio of the percentage of district- wise receipts from fisheries. This information is provided by Fisheries department which is contained in Statistical Abstract of Punjab.

Mining and Quarrying: The estimates of GSVA from this sector are based on district-wise production and value of minerals.

Manufacturing: The state level estimates of GSVA from this sector are allocated to the districts on the basis of ratio of No. of industrial workers engaged in manufacturing industries according to Economic Census 2012 in the districts.

Construction: The estimates of GSVA from various sub-sectors under this sector are distributed among different districts on the basis of work force engaged in related construction activity as per Economic Census (2012).

Electricity, Gas and Water Supply: The State level estimates of income from electricity sub-sector are distributed among various districts according to total consumption of power in each district. In case of Water Supply, estimates are prepared on the basis of number of workers engaged in the respective services at

the district level. In case of Gas Sub-sector estimates are prepared on the basis of number of gohar gas plants in districts.

Transport, Storage and Communication: The district-wise estimates of GSVA of this sector are prepared separately for railways, communication and storage sub-sectors by allocating the State level estimates on the basis of working force engaged in this sector. In case of transport by other means, district-wise number of motor vehicles is used to allocate state level estimates to districts.

Trade, Hotels and Restaurants: The estimates of GSVA from trade, hotels and restaurants sub-sectors are distributed among districts with the help of working force engaged in relevant activities in districts as per Economic census 2012.

Banking and Insurance: The State level estimates of income from this sector are allocated to the districts on the basis of number of Banking Offices in each district of the state. This information is provided by local office of Reserve Bank of India and is contained in Statistical Abstract of state.

Real Estate, Ownership of Dwellings and Business Services: The estimates of GSVA from Real Estate, Ownership of Dwellings and Business Services are bifurcated among districts on the basis of district-wise number of workers engaged in these services. The number of workers engaged in these services is taken from Economic census 2012.

Public Administration: To prepare district-wise income estimates in respect of Central Govt., State Govt. Local Bodies and Autonomous Institution sub-sectors, the GSVA of these sub-sectors is divided among districts in the ratio of percentages of number of State Govt. employees in the districts.

Other Services: District-wise percentages are used to distribute GSVA of different sub-sector in all districts. For the Education, district- wise percentage of number of teachers in all institutions is used whereas for Medical and Health the district-wise percentage of number of Medical & Para Medical workers is applied. The information regarding district-wise number of teachers and Medical & Para Medical worker is provided by Education and Health Department respectively which is incorporated in Statistical Abstract of Punjab.

For Sanitation Services, the district-wise percentage of number of sanitation workers in municipalities is used for allocating SDP of sub-sector to districts.
