Please refer to the subject cited above.

2. The Govt. of India has restructured 20-Point Programme called 20 Point Programme-2006(TPP-06),it has become operational w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup>April, 2007. Under this Programme 66 items/Schemes are be covered. out of which 25 items are monthly monitorable, (list enclosed) and the remaining items are annually monitorable.The Govt of India Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (Gol), has introduced three-tier monitoring system i.e. State Level, District Level and Block Level to monitor the progress of items/schemes covered under TPP-06. The formation of District planning and development board constituted by the state Govt are similar as suggested by Govt. of India. Therefore, the State Govt. has decided to entrust the monitoring of TPP-06 to the District planning and development board in the State.

3. You are, therefore, requested to ensure the monitoring of schemes covered under 20-Point Programme along with plan schemes in future.
